I served as an Oracle School District governing board member for eight years and now as the Vice-Chairman of the Pinal County Board Supervisors representing District 4. These experiences give me a unique perspective on both the District's needs and the funding required to address those needs. All Arizona district schools receive the same basic per pupil funding. Those schools who receive locally supported funding in the form of overrides though, are able to offer a more comprehensive curriculum. This, combined with higher quality teachers and moderate class sizes, ensures our students will eventually be ready to help lead Pinal County (one of the fastest growing in the Nation) into the future. I don't believe additional funding is automatically the answer. But, where funding requests are reasonable, and leadership is held accountable for delivering on promises made, it can make good sense. This has been the case for the Oracle School District. OSD has improved academic achievement, and increased its state grade from a "C" to a "B". To protect the progress made, I urge your YES vote for the Oracle School District's override continuation this November.

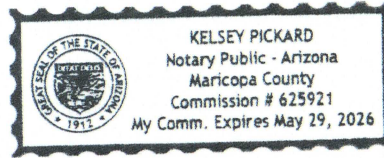
