I' ve followed Board discussions of this bond issue since February, and feel that the pro's outweigh the cons. However, there are concerns that in the resolution that voters need to be aware of. In addition to the renovations, repairs, maintenance and equipment purchases, there have been discussions of adding new facilities, beyond necessities, to improve the attractiveness of the campuses, as well as acquiring property to address new growth in SW Apache Junction. While this measure allows for the raising of money, exactly how that money is spent, within the parameters in exhibit A, capital expenditures still need approval by current and future Board members, so citizens can still weigh in on those issues as they arise. While this money should cover a school site, the construction of that school may require additional bond approvals. Reducing the tax rate from about \$.60 per \$100 to \$.21 assumes an amortization of 20 years, so if a new issue is needed, this reduction is only temporary. Shorter maturities that will save money and even out the tax reductions will also have to be decided by future Board members. Despite these concerns, the pros outweigh the cons. Steve Hetsler
